WHEREAS 2021 is a year of historical significance for Dauphin, marking the 125th anniversary of the settlement of the “new town” of Dauphin in 1896;

AND WHEREAS 1896 saw the founding of Dauphin through a series of historic events, including the designation of the “new town” as Section 10 on September 9th, the sale of the first lots on October 7th, the laying of railway tracks across Main Street on November 7th, and the dispatch of the first telegram from Dauphin to the “outside world” on November 9th;

AND WHEREAS 2021 also marks the 100th anniversary of the Main Street Pedestrian Subway and the 80th anniversary of the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan and the airports at Dauphin and Paulson;

AND WHEREAS the study and commemoration of the history of our city promotes a spirit of belonging, pride, and identity;
