## Chief Administrative Officer's Retirement

Mayor and Council of the City of Dauphin accept with regret the resignation of Chief Administrative Officer, Brad Collett. Brad and his wife have chosen an early retirement, and we wish them health and happiness as they enter this new chapter in their lives.

Brad has been the Chief Administrative Officer for the City of Dauphin for 16 years. His leadership, integrity, and astute financial stewardship transformed Dauphin into a "can do" community. In his time with the City, Brad was the driving force behind many positive changes in the City's operations, including deficit reduction, debt repayment, the stabilizing of property taxes, and the lowering of the mill rate. With his guidance, Dauphin City Council built a first-class recreation facility (now debt-free), spurred downtown development, increased public works spending on road, water, and sewer infrastructure, and modernized waste and recycling collection – all without raising property taxes.
